- 1 **Viura, Candidato** *La Mancha, Spain* **4.75 6.65 16.95**

Produced by one of Rioja leading winery with grapes from Castilla la Mancha. Viura, also known as Macabeo, is the staple grape of white Rioja. Crisp, fruity and refreshing.

- 2 **Chenin Blanc, Neil Joubert** **4.85 6.95 17.95**

Stellenbosch, South Africa

Chenin is also known as Pinot de la Loire (France). Commonly known in South Africa as "steen" and likely to have been introduced there by the Huguenots fleeing persecution. Since 1898 the Joubert family have been the custodians of the Klein-Simonsvlei farm.

- 3 **Pinot Grigio, Terre del Noce, Mezzacorona** *Trentino, Italy* **5.20 7.50 19.50**

The vineyards are situated on the slope of the Noce river an affluent of the Aldige at the foothill of the Dolomite near the medieval town of Trento in the Trentino area North of Verona. Elegant dry and clean style.

- 4 **Pinot Bianco, Quercus** *Goriska Brda, Slovenia* **20.50**

The vineyards are situated on the slope of the Noce river an affluent of the Aldige at the foothill of the Dolomite near the medieval town of Trento in the Trentino area North of Verona. Elegant dry and clean style.

- 5 **Chardonnay/ Pinot Grigio, Artisan's Blend** *Victoria, Australia* **4.95 7.25 18.95**

A classic combination. Where the result is greater than the sum of the parts. Unoaked white fruit and citrusy freshness.

- 6 **Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, Pionero, Morandé** *Maule, Chile* **5.10 7.50 19.50**

Maule was one of the first planted areas at the start of colonisation, 250 km south of Santiago along the Maule river in Chile. Vivid aromas full of flavour dry and refreshing.

- 7 **Sauvignon Blanc, Coopers Creek** *Marlborough, New Zealand* **6.50 8.95 23.95**

Located in the north of the South Island, Marlborough is the largest wine growing region of New Zealand. Named after John Churchill 1st Duke of Marlborough, an English General and Statesman. Intensely fragrant and lively.

- 8 **Chablis, Jean-Marc Brocard** *Burgundy, France* **32.00**

Pure expression of Chardonnay planted on Kimmeridgian soil similar to the White Cliffs of Dover and the Sancerre region Unfortunately the area is very vulnerable to frost. In 2016, 50% of the crop was lost. Steely, mineral and fresh. Text book Chablis from a top producer.

- 9 **Gavi di Gavi La Contessa** *Piedmont, Italy* **28.95**

Fresh and elegant with nutty aromas, a great classic from Northern Italy, 100% Cortese grapes.

- 10 **Shiraz/ Mourvedre/Viognier, Front Row** **4.75 6.65 16.95**

Swartland, South Africa

Not just for Rugby! Smooth and juicy red, packed with ripe flavours.

- 11 **Merlot, Santa Alegra** **4.95 7.25 18.95**

Central Valley, Chile

Thought to be a diminutive of "merle" the French name for Black bird, Merlot has become very popular around the world and often blended with Cabernet specially in Bordeaux. Smooth, plummy juicy fruit, medium bodied.

- 12 **Garnacha, Finca el Sapo** **19.50**

Cariñena, Aragón, Spain

The grenache grape is known as Cannonau in Italy and needs hot, dry conditions to develop fully. Most likely originated in Northern Spain it has now spread around the World, from the Rhone Valley to Australia. Smooth and lively with velvety aromas.

- 13 **Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Pionero, Morandé** *Maipo Valley, Chile* **5.20 7.50 19.50**

Hardy and naturally low yielding with great ageing potential. Widely planted around the world, it found a perfect home in Maipo Valley. Sophisticated Cabernet with classic blackcurrant and cherry fruit.

- 14 **Malbec, Finca La Colonia, Bodega Norton** **5.50 7.75 20.30**

Mendoza, Argentina

This 1st winery in this now famous area was created in 1885 by an English engineer Sir Edmund James Norton who fell in love with the region while working on the Trans Andean railway connecting Mendoza in Argentina to Santiago in Chile. Smooth, generous, deep red and very juicy.

Victoria, Australia

Shiraz, or "Syrah", is from the Rhone region. It has grown in popularity with Australian export of late 20th century. Modern style, juicy, spicy and, with a rounded finish.

- 16 **Rioja Crianza Promesa, Martinez Bujanda** **6.10 8.75 23.75**

Rioja, Spain

The first testimony of viticulture dates back to 1063, with monks at the forefront of winemaking. In 1991 the prestigious "Calificada" nomination was awarded making it Spain 1st Denominacion de Origen Calificada with strict regulations. A classic style of mature Rioja.

- 17 **Peppoli Chianti Classico, Antinori** **32.50**

Tuscany, Italy



The Antinori family have been producing wines for 26 generations. The single estate of Peppoli is considered a benchmark in Tuscany, produced in the heartland of the appellation recognised with the "gallo nero" or black rooster. Intense red fruit aromas, mature and perfectly crafted.
